Unity for Autism Grant Update



Unity for Autism's generous grant has allowed the Clinic to hire a Behaviour Therapist. Until now, parents waited several months for this service.

Children are now being screened by the Behaviour Therapist on their first visit to the clinic. Parents are provided with strategies that they can implement right away. This often leads to parents seeing positive behaviour changes in a relatively short time.

Approximately 100 children per year will benefit from this service.

Did you know?

A new service! February 17, 2009 the Ministry of Children and Youth Services and the Ministry of Education announced a joint initiative for students with autism.

Connections for Students is a service that will provide student support to the education system specifically for children who are being discharged from intensive behavioural intervention (IBI) and will be attending a publicly funded school. The goal of the service is to support the school as they develop an ABA-based education plan for a child. This service will not transfer a child's IBI to the school setting. This service will be provided by both the Autism Spectrum Disorder School Support Program (ASD SSP) and a child's school. waiting times. The first \$1,000,000 has already been given to OCTC with the remaining \$2,000,000 being given over the next two years (2011-2012).

The ASD Video Glossary is an innovative webbased tool designed to help parents and professionals learn more about the early red flags and diagnostic features of autism spectrum disorders (ASD).

This glossary contains over a hundred video clips and is available to you free of charge. Whether you are a parent, family member, friend, physician, clinician, childcare provider, or educator, it can help you see the subtle differences between typical and delayed development in young children and spot the early red flags for ASD. All of the children featured in the ASD Video Glossary as having red flags for ASD are, in fact, diagnosed with ASD. Apps for children with Autism. Many of the apps offered for iPhones and iPads aren't just for fun or everyday organization -- they're designed specifically to teach skills to children with special needs and to make communication or behavior management easier.
